Get promoted to **Behavior Technician**. Receive in-depth training and supervision to broaden your skills and knowledge while working in advanced home-based ABA programs.

Recommended timeline:
1-2 years (part-time or full-time) with 3-5 clients

3. Help develop and supervise ABA programs

Get promoted to an **Assistant Clinical Specialist**. Complete your Master's degree and required courses in Behavior Analysis. 1-2 years (full-time)
